Prize presentation at approximately 12:45 at Cople Village Hall.

Course Details:

Start: Start from Cople Village Hall. The race is neutralised. Proceed along unclassified road towards Cardington. Race will then be deneutralised. Continue through Cardington, passing over disused railway bridge (M-marshall) and crossing finish line for first time at top of hill some 2 miles after Cardington (lap board shows 5 laps to go). Race continues to next T-junction (M) where left towards Old Warden. Proceed through Old Warden village with care around left-hand bend (M), and take next left (M) towards Ickwell taking care on narrow descent (M). The race continues to Northill taking first left (M) toward Cople, where first left (M) toward Cardington to complete first lap on crossing finish line.

Finish: Approximately 2 miles after Cardington on the rise of the hill after completing 5.2 laps - approx. 90 kilometres

Notes for riders:

Ensure that no rubbish is left on / around the circuit.

There are toilet facilities in the village hall - please do not use hedgerows on the circuit.

Please do not park on the course (including on the road just outside the HQ). There is ample parking in the village hall car park.

Signing on and bike check:

Please arrive in plenty of time to sign on, collect your number and if a junior, to have your gear checked. The HQ will open at 08:00. Latest signing on time will be 09:10 (20 minutes before the start). Those without BC licences must pay for a day licence. Juniors will be asked to submit their bikes for gear checking when they sign on.

The Chief Commissaire will brief riders 10 minutes before the start. Please assemble in the HQ car park for 09:20.

Neutral service:

There will be a neutral service vehicle following at the back of the convoy. Wheels will be collected in a designated area of the HQ – please label them with your number (or numbers in your team) so that we can get you back on the road as soon as possible. There will be very limited provision for those who don't supply their own wheels – don't rely on it.
