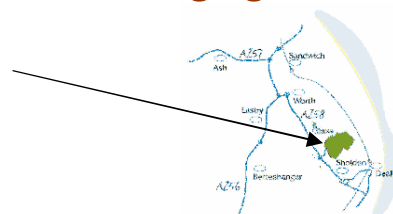

Features the adults' race at 12:00 noon and an Under-12s race at 10:30am

## **Venue information**

Found off the A258 between Deal and Sandwich (but much nearer to Deal!), Fowlmead Country Park was opened in May 2007 on the site of the former spoil tip of Betteshanger Colliery.

Fowlmead Country Park boasts a 2-mile closed Tarmac road race track which has been used for a host of national and regional road race and time trial events in addition to World Handcycling Federation time trails.

In addition, Fowlmead offers fantastic mountainbiking and cyclocross trails over its 200 acres incorporating woods and fast open areas.

- Ample car parking – costs just £1 for the whole day
- A Visitor Centre with café (10am to 4pm on Saturdays and Sundays), hot showers, toilets including disabled toilets
- Bike wash facility available

## **Event information**

A series of four Mountainbike Races under British Cycling rules. Race for fun, Race your friends, or Race to win! Register from 10am, collect your race number and transponder and practise from 11am (after the children's U12 race which starts at 10:30am). Overall series prizes (best 3 races of the 4 to count). Pre-entry prices via [www.riderhq.com](http://www.riderhq.com) are £8 for over 18s and £4 for any rider of 17 years and under. Pre-entry via [www.riderhq.com](http://www.riderhq.com) will close at 18:00 on the Saturday before the event. Entry on the day will be £10 for adults and £5 for any rider of 17 years and under. Plenty of car parking - please remember to pay your £1.00 for all-day parking.

Racing is on a fast all-weather surface of predominantly shale (from the park's previous life as the spoil tip of Betteshanger Colliery). A testing and fun course with generally wide, but twisting and turning paths through the wooded sections, interspersed with open grassy sections.
